



ECLIPSE AT SEA

BASIC SAFETY ADVICE

Enjoy the eclipse safely. Heavy boat traffic is expected and patrols will be stepped up. Please follow these rules:



Prepare your gear: Check the weather before heading out. Make sure you carry life jackets, lights, and flares. Secure all loose items on board.



Navigate with caution: Respect speed limits and keep a safe distance from other boats. Watch out for swimmers and maintain a continuous watch on VHF Channel 16.



Protect the sea: Bring all waste back to shore. Anchoring on Posidonia seagrass meadows is strictly prohibited.



Skipper's responsibility: Exceptional events do not change the rules. Zero tolerance for drinking and driving. Do not raft vessels together and never use flares for fun.



Use ISO 12312-2:2015 glasses: Wet glasses will not protect your eyes. Never look at the sun without approved eyewear. Take special care of children and the elderly.



Emergencies: If you need assistance, call on VHF Channel 16 or dial 112.
